AppleShare 4.0 Print Server: Not Printing Error Pages (1/94)

TOPIC -----

I have set AppleShare 4.0 Print Server, banner page to off. However, when a print job is deleted from the print-queue, a page kicks out indicating that the print job has been deleted.

Is this "feature" changeable? I have an expensive output device, and I'm disturbed by the waste of supplies and time having such information printed.

DISCUSSION -----

There is no supported method for preventing the AppleShare Print Server 4.0.x software from printing error pages. However, we have a ResEdit patch that will prevent AppleShare Print Server 3.0.x, AppleShare Print Server 4.0.x, and AppleShare Print Server Pro from printing error pages. Here are the directions:

- 1) Use ResEdit to open the AppleShare Print Server application.
- 2) Open the "EXOP" resource with an ID of 128; it should be the only one.
- 3) Change the first four zeros (0000) to ones (1111).
- 4) Quit ResEdit saving the changes made to the AppleShare Print Server application.

Now the AppleShare Print Server application should no longer print error pages.
