Apple Workgroup Server 95: Delay In File Management (6/93)

TOPIC -----

Is there a significant delay in basic file management when renaming an existing folder, moving folders into another folder, or opening folders? It is not acceptable to wait more than a few seconds for a window to display the contents of a folder with approximately 20 files.

DISCUSSION -----

No, improvement is seen over the current use of NFS shared services.

The performance with about 20 files in a folder is about 1-2 seconds to open the folder. This performance can also depend on the CPU being used as the client workstation.
