AWS 95: Mounting & Sharing Other NFS Volumes (6/93)

TOPIC -----

Can I mount a SUN NFS volume to an Apple Workgroup Server (AWS) 95 in order to access our SUN CADD server and make its data available to all Macintosh users? Also, would you recommend this arrangement (mounting SUN NFS volumes) for re-exporting 12 SUN file systems from one AWS 95? What impact does the NFS keep alive traffic have on AWS 95 performance?

DISCUSSION -----

You can NFS mount any file system exported by the SUN and then make the mount point a Shared Item in the AppleShare Pro Admin program. We would not recommend this setup unless it was absolutely necessary. The keep alive traffic should have very little effect on the performance of the system. However, the access performance on this kind of shared item would not be as good as the one obtained from local volumes.
