Apple Workgroup Server 95 and Authentication daemons (6/93)

TOPIC -----

Is there a need to run PC/NFS, BWNFSD and/or another authentication daemons on the Apple Workgroup Server (AWS) 95?

DISCUSSION -----

To run AppleShare Pro and have Macintosh Clients you do not need to run either PC/NFSD or BWNFSD. For the AWS 95 to become an NFS server, you have to configure the kernel to have NFS support via a simple `newconfig` command (`newconfig nfs`). This will start `/etc/nfsd`. If the system will also be used as an NFS client, the `/etc/biod` can also be started.
