| I'm getting screen interference on my computer from a transformer outside my home. I've tried all sorts of surge supressors, all to no avail. Any other suggestions?  |
| DISCUSSION  |
| Is your interference coming directly from power lines or from electromagnetic interference (EMI) in the air? If it's from power lines, you'll need a "high-end power filter" costing around \$200 and up.   |
| Your problem sounds like general electromagnetic interference. The only thing you can do is move your monitor as far away as possible from the source of interference. You can also try putting some shielding around the monitor to protect it from EMI.  Copyright 1991, Apple Computer, Inc. |
