Macintosh IIVx: Radius Video Card and System Crashes (7/93)

TOPIC -----

Is there a problem with the Macintosh IIVx (Performa 600) and the Radius Video Card?

DISCUSSION -----

There is a known incompatibility between the installed base of Radius video cards and the Macintosh IIVx (Performa 600), which may result in system crashes.

Radius has corrected the problem and has updated all presently shipping models of their video interface cards and software. Users who desire to upgrade their video interface cards to provide IIVx compatibility may obtain a Software Upgrade Kit by contacting Radius Technical Support.
