Performa 400: Printing to a Citizen Swift 200 (8/96)

TOPIC -----

Can I connect a Performa 400 to a Citizen Swift 200 centronics printer? Would the Macintosh Print Pack be of any benefit?

DISCUSSION -----

Apple was unable to obtain any information on the Citizen Swift 200 printer since it is a European product. We contacted Citizen USA and they referred us to Citizen Europe Corporation for any questions related to the Citizen Swift 200 printer. Citizen Europe Corporation can be reached (from the USA) by calling at 011-44-753-584-111. They are located in the United Kingdom.

However, if the Citizen Swift 200 printer can emulate an Epson (FX or LQ), Kodak (Diconix 701), or Canon (BJ-10ex) standard then the Macintosh Print Pack will work for your customer. Here are the specific drivers included with the Print Pack and the types of printers they support:

Driver/standard	Printer Type
Epson FX	9-pin dot matrix printers or some line printers
Epson LQ	24-pin dot matrix printers
Canon BJ-10ex	Compact/Portable Ink-Jet printers
Diconix 701	Compact/Portable Ink-Jet printers

These drivers are all selectable in the Chooser. The Print Pack also comes with a serial to parallel cable (din8 to Centronics) for the hardware interface.
