Power Macintosh: Upgrades Available (9/96)

TOPIC -----

This article describes the Power Macintosh Upgrade Card, the Macintosh Processor Upgrade Card, and the Power Macintosh Logic Board Upgrades.

DISCUSSION -----

Macintosh owners who want the new high-speed capabilities of Power Macintosh computers, but don't want to sacrifice their previous investments have several upgrade options: the Power Macintosh Upgrade Card (which is no longer available from Apple Computer), the Macintosh Processor Upgrade Card, and the Power Macintosh Logic board Upgrades.

You can install the Power Macintosh Upgrade Card (which is no longer available from Apple Computer) into the 68040 processor-direct slot of your Macintosh computer yourself by following simple, step-by-step instructions. The card adds the benefits of Power Macintosh technology to your Macintosh and provides speeds up to four times faster when using programs optimized for Power Macintosh technology. And you can still run all your existing Macintosh applications.

The Macintosh Processor Upgrade Card upgrades some 68040 systems with the PowerPC microprocessor. It is available for the Macintosh Quadra 605, Macintosh LC 475, Performa 47x, Macintosh LC 57x, Performa 57x, Macintosh LC 580, Performa 58x, Macintosh LC 630, Macintosh Quadra 630, and Performa 630 series of computers. Once installed, the upgrade occupies the LC-PDS slot of your Macintosh computer.

In addition, even greater performance, as well as speech and telephone capabilities, can be yours if you choose the appropriate Power Macintosh Logic Board Upgrade for your Macintosh. These logic board upgrades give your computer capabilities identical to those of the Power Macintosh model to which you've upgraded.

Installation of both the Macintosh Processor Upgrade Card and the Power Macintosh Logic Board Upgrade must be performed by an authorized Apple reseller. Your upgraded computer will retain your existing hard drive and, in most cases, your DRAM SIMMs, allowing you to take advantage of Power Macintosh capabilities and software written to take advantage of those capabilities.

The Power Macintosh Upgrade Card, the Macintosh Processor Upgrade Card, and the Power Macintosh Logic Board Upgrade give you the best of both worlds: Power Macintosh capabilities designed for the future, built on the foundation of the investment you already have in your Macintosh today.
