DAL for Sybase on OS/2 (3/93)

TOPIC -----

I'm interested in accessing Sybase on OS/2 via DAL. Is a DAL server available? If not, would I be able to access Sybase using GQL or DataPrism on a Macintosh using Sybase's Open Client.

DISCUSSION -----

DAL does not have a server that runs on the OS/2 platform.

However, both GQL and DataPrism support access to the Sybase Open Client product, which operates as a server on OS/2.

For GQL, this server is referred to as "DB Library" rather than Sybase Open Client in the connection selection window.

For DataPrism, release 1.8 or higher is required and then the Sybase Open Client is supported as a server connection selection.
