Macintosh Standard DAs: Documented in Balloon Help (8/93)

TOPIC -----

Some recent Macintosh manuals don't describe how to use the standard desk accessories (DAs), the small programs that appear under the Apple menu and are included with every Macintosh system. In some cases, the Scrapbook DA contains the text "See your owner's guide for more information" but the owner's guide doesn't have more information about the Scrapbook.

DISCUSSION -----

There are several versions of the Macintosh User's Guide, and they differ in the information they provide about desk accessories. If this information is missing from your manual, simply turn on Balloon Help. (This applies to Macintosh systems with System software version 7.0 or later.)

- 1) Choose "Show Balloons" from the "?" menu.
- 2) Choose a desk accessory from the Apple menu.
- 3) As you move the mouse pointer around the DA, help balloons will describe the DA's functions.
- 4) To turn off Balloon Help, choose "Hide Balloons" from the "?" menu.
