Can I use Virtual Memory on ejectable media (like a Bernoulli box)?

DISCUSSION -----

No. Virtual Memory will not let you select a "removable" hard disk for the storage of your Virtual Memory "swap file" (For this reason, removable hard disks are grayed-out in the Memory Control Panel.) If you use a removable hard disk and a normal hard disk, choose the normal hard disk for the Virtual Memory Swap file.

If the only hard disk attached to your Macintosh is a removable one, you cannot use System 7's Virtual Memory feature.
