Powerbook: Adobe Type Manager 3.0 and Suitcase II 2.0 (5/93)

TOPIC -----

My Powerbook crashes when I have Adobe Type Manager version 3.0 and Suitcase II, version 2.0 installed at the same time.

DISCUSSION -----

There is a conflict between these two system extensions. The conflict only occurs on a Macintosh that use a system enabler. Macintosh systems introduced on or after October 19,1992 use enablers. This problem will also happen with the 32-Bit enabler, which customers might use on the Macintosh II, Macintosh IIX, Macintosh IICX, or the Macintosh SE/30.

Adobe and Fifth Generation Systems, Inc. are aware of the problem and are working on it. Suitcase version 2.1.3 fixes this problem. Contact Fifth Generation Systems, Inc. for an update.
