Retrospect: Error 108 (out of application memory) (8/93)

TOPIC -----

What is "Error 108 (out of application memory)" in Retrospect?

DISCUSSION -----

Error 108 (out of application memory) means that Retrospect needs more memory.

What to do: Increase the memory you have allocated to Retrospect by using the Get Info command from the Finder's File menu. The following is a guide for how much memory Retrospect will need to back up large volumes:

- 1,700K for 3,500 files/folders (This is the default setting.)
- 4,000K for 10,000 files/folders
- 6,000K for 20,000 files/folders
- 8,000K for 32,000 files/folders

If you are backing up volumes that contain a large number of files, you may need more than the recommended amount of memory.
