Super ATM: Problems After Rebuilt Desktop (2/94)

TOPIC -----

After I rebuilt my desktop file, some files are displayed as generic icons.

Also, some documents which previously opened, now won't open when I double click them. In the Get Info window, these icons are named "Document".

What causes this?

DISCUSSION -----

This is caused by having Super Adobe Type Manager (ATM) loaded when you rebuilt your desktop. Adobe is aware of the problem and recommends the following workaround:

1) Turn off Super ATM and restart your system. You can do this by:

- Turning off Super ATM from the Control Panel

OR

- Rebooting your Macintosh with the Shift key held down to turn Extensions off.

2) Rebuild your Desktop file by restarting your Macintosh and holding the Option and Command keys down during the startup process.

3) Turn on Super ATM and restart your Macintosh.

According to Adobe, this problem fixed in version 3.6 of Super ATM.
