## HyperCard 2.1: Can't Dial with PowerBook Fax/Data Modem

TOPIC -----

I tried to use the PowerBook Fax/Data modem in my PowerBook 100 from HyperCard 2.1, but couldn't get it to work. I used the DIAL command like this, for an example:

```
DIAL "090510" WITH MODEM  
or  
DIAL "090510" WITH MODEM "ATS0=0S7=1DT"
```

I tried this in a script of a button and even tried it in the message box. Nothing happens! All that I can see is that the hand cursor becomes the watch cursor, and stays that way for a short time.

I tried this on a PowerBook 100, 140, and 170 with 4MB RAM and HyperCard 2.1.

DISCUSSION -----

Claris Tech Support is currently working on the problem, but unfortunately there's no workaround available at this time. They said that the incompatibility only involves the Apple PowerBook Fax/Data Modem, not any of the third-party PowerBook modems.
