## Power Macintosh: QuarkXpress System Bomb (12/94)

TOPIC -----

We get a System Bomb on our Power Macintosh systems ("Floating Point Co-processor not installed") when we place a 45 MB CMYK Photoshop file into QuarkXpress. Both applications are native. The error is intermittent but frequent. Any suggestions?

DISCUSSION -----

According to Quark non-Apple extensions running in 68K emulation can sometimes generate a "Coprocessor Not Installed" message when a large file is imported into QuarkXPress. Quark recommends that users restart their system with extensions off to confirm that this is the cause of the problem. They mentioned that the most common cause is an older (non-native) version of Adobe Type Manager. The latest native version of ATM that I am aware of is version 3.8.1. QuarkXPress version 3.3.1 is the latest version of native QuarkXPress.
