## Quadra 900 & 950: Internal CD-ROM Drive Issues (5/93)

TOPIC -----

I would like to install a CD-ROM drive in a Quadra 900 and need the AppleCD bezel part number -- the slotted one that replaces the blank bezel (076-0431) when you put the AppleCD under the SuperDrive.

DISCUSSION -----

You can install a CD-ROM drive in a Quadra 900 or 950, but it does not ship in this configuration from Apple. Therefore, Apple does not carry or supply the parts for this configuration on the Price Pages. Apple does not sell parts for configurations that have not been tested nor qualified (the AppleCD 300i was never tested in this system).

Some third-party companies sell CD kits that come with their CD-ROM mechanism (which they have tested and qualified) and includes cables and the bezel.
