## System 7.5: Systems With Easy Access Pre-installed (11/94)

### TOPIC -----

All new computers that ship with 7.5 should not have the Easy Access control panel pre-installed in the System Folder. This is because the "Easy Install" of System 7.5 is used for the Custom Macintosh Bundles, and the "Easy Install" does not include the Easy Access control panel.

### DISCUSSION -----

We are aware of the following configurations that come with Easy Access pre-installed. They ship with System 7.1 and a System 7.5 Installer on the hard drive. They are:

- Macintosh PowerBook Duos, No Modem, 4 MB RAM
- Macintosh PowerBook 500 series, No Modem, 4 MB RAM
- PowerBook 150, No Modem, 4 MB RAM

The Custom Macintosh group confirmed that the Easy Access control panel comes pre-installed with these bundles. We are currently working with the Custom Macintosh group to try to get this changed so that the Easy Access control panel is not pre-installed on these systems.

The only other known scenario of where customers might have Easy Access installed with System 7.5 would be if they upgraded from a previous version of the operating system
