Newton: How to Set the Date and Time (7/93)

TOPIC-----

This article discusses how to set the date and time on your Newton.

DISCUSSION-----

To set the date:

- 1) Tap the Extras button at the bottom of Newton's screen, then tap Prefs.
- 2) Tap Date and Time.
- 3) To set the month and year, use the arrows at the top of the calendar to scroll through.
- 4) To set the day, tap the current date on the calendar.

To set the time:

- 1) Tap the Extras button at the bottom of Newton's screen, then tap Prefs.
- 2) Tap Date and Time.
- 3) Draw a long hand and a short hand in the proper positions on the analog clock shown. Be sure your long hand reaches the border of the clock, and your short hand is about half the radius of the clock face.
- 4) Tap the Set button.
