The Sony GDM-1601 and Sony GDM-1602 monitors are not compatible with the Macintosh 1-bit, 4-bit, or 8-bit video cards. These monitors may be compatible with video cards from companies like RasterOps, Radius, or SuperMac Technologies. Check with them for more information. The primary difference between the two displays is that the Sony GDM-1601 has a display resolution of 1280 x 1024, while the Sony GDM-1602 has a display resolution of 1024 x 768.
