How to Clean a Mouse: Instructions Are in the Manual

TOPIC -----

I am having a problem cleaning my mouse. I thought I did everything correctly, but the mouse is still "jumpy" (usually a sign of a dirty mouse). Where can I find a document explaining the cleaning procedure?

DISCUSSION -----

The directions on how to clean the Macintosh mouse is in one of the manuals that comes with each Macintosh system. For example, look in the index of the "Macintosh Plus Owner's Guide" under "cleaning." You should see an entry for the mouse (pages 196 and 197). For the Macintosh IIfx, look in the "Macintosh Reference" manual that comes with it. In the index under "cleaning", there is an entry for the mouse (pages 294 through 296).

If cleaning the mouse as described in the manual does not correct the problem, the mouse may need to be replaced. Have a service technician check it.
