Far right: Frequency: 150 lpi; Screen Angle: 0 degrees Middle right: Frequency: 106 lpi; Screen Angle: 45 degrees Center: Frequency: 83 lpi; Screen Angle: 56 degrees Middle left: Frequency: 75 lpi; Screen Angle: 0 degrees Far Left: Frequency: 53 lpi; Screen Angle: 45 degrees Note: The "Middle right" setting is the default PhotoGrade setting.
