LaserWriter IIg: Won't Print Tilde and Apostrophe (8/95)

TOPIC -----

I upgraded my LaserWriter IINT to a LaserWriter IIg. The IIg will not print any apostrophes or tildes. I can replace the printer's logic board with a IINT and it will print the tilde and apostrophe.

DISCUSSION -----

Try removing New Century Schoolbook font and rebooting. The New Century Schoolbook font that ships with the IIf/IIg is damaged. This font will cause the tilde and apostrophe to fail to print.

Reinstall the font from the Font Pack diskettes rather than from the LaserWriter Pro or LaserWriter IIf disks.
