Are there refurbishment kits for Apple Laser printers? If not, is there a List of parts that are "recommended for replacement"?

Also, what is the expected life of these printers?

DISCUSSION -----

The LaserWriter II engine is the only Apple printer that has a refurbishment kit.

LaserWriter II

- Refurbishment kit part number: 652-0597
- Minimum life expectancy is 300K pages.

Personal LaserWriter SC/NT/NTR/LS

- Has a life of 150K pages
- Recommended that the fuser be changed after 100K pages.

Select 300/310:

- Has a life of 150K pages or five years.
- Recommended that the fuser be changed after 100K pages.

Select 360:

- Has a life of 300K pages or five years.
- Recommended that the fuser be changed after 100K pages.

LaserWriter Pro 600/630:

- Has a life of 450K pages or five years.
- For that engine the following parts are recommended for replacement after 200K pages:
 - Fuser Assembly
 - Transfer Roller
 - MP Tray Pickup Rollers
 - MP Tray Guide Assembly
 - Cassette Pickup Rollers

Personal LaserWriter 320:

- Print engine life: Up to 8K pages monthly maximum recommended
