This article describes the LaserWriter Pro 810 printer.

DISCUSSION -----

The LaserWriter Pro 810 is based on the Fuji Xerox 20 page per minute xerographic engine. Designed for enterprise-wide connectivity, it delivers high quality output, expanded paper handling, and flexibility in mixed environments. The LaserWriter Pro 810 uses 400-dot-per-inch engine technology combined with controller technology that supports up to 800-dot-per-inch print resolution, providing the highest quality available from a LaserWriter.

It can print on a wide variety of paper sizes with three, 250-sheet universal cassettes standard. Optional cassettes and an automated feeder are available for additional sizes and paper thicknesses.

This printer provides advanced connectivity required in high end laser printers. With its built-in Ethernet, LocalTalk, and Serial ports it can print documents generated by many different types of computers, including those running Macintosh, MS-DOS, Windows, or UNIX operating systems. The built-in network card allows the printer to communicate with many network operating systems concurrently via multiple protocols, including TCP/IP, EtherTalk, NetWare IPX, and Digital LAT, further increasing your connectivity options.

 - Necessary software drivers and utilities to support DOS and Windows are included

 - Single sheet manual feed tray
 - Optional cassettes support executive and folio paper sizes
 - Allows printing on envelopes, labels, transparencies, and letterhead or plain paper

- Uses Virtual Printer technology, the controller automatically switches to the appropriate emulation, in accordance with the network source address of the incoming data stream
 - NetWare IPX, AppleTalk, TCP/IP, and Digital LAT protocol support over Ethernet
 - Supports PostScript Level 2 and PCL 4+, offers seamless transfer between page description languages
 - 400-dot-per-inch native engine resolution with controller technology allowing 600 and 800-dot-per-inch resolutions
 - Optional Internal PostScript fax cartridge is available to take advantage of printer's fax send/recieve capability and allow up to 800-dot-per-inch crisp, plain paper printing of PostScript faxes as well as standard faxes
