## StyleWriter II: Software Install Error (8/94)

TOPIC -----

I'm trying to install StyleWriter II software from our original StyleWriter II disks on a Power Macintosh 7100/66. I'm getting the following error when doing an Easy Install:

"The selected disk has System 7 installed, the custom installation you have selected is only for disks where System 6 is installed. Please click Switch Disk to choose a different disk or insert a floppy disk."

DISCUSSION -----

We were able to duplicate this problem, and most likely the original StyleWriter II Installer script wasn't aware of the new Power Macintosh computers or new system software. This issue can also arise on any computer introduced after the StyleWriter II such as the PowerBook 500 series and 280/280c.

The latest StyleWriter II software (version 1.2) is on the Power Macintosh Install disks, and is part of the Easy Install for the Power Macintosh as well as being pre-installed on the PowerBook computers.

You might want to do a Custom Install, so that the additional fonts are installed on your Power Macintosh. The fonts are the only things that you need to install from the StyleWriter II software disks.
