

Important Information

Before you use your Apple MessagePad 120 with the Newton 2.0 operating system, it is important that you make a backup copy of the pre-installed software packages.

Also, before you install any software packages, please consult the Newton 2.0 Applications List to see if the packages work with the Newton 2.0 operating system.



Backing up pre-installed software packages using a storage card

Apple recommends you use the Newton Backup Utility instead of a storage card to backup any information from your MessagePad. If you can't use the Newton Backup Utility (for example, if you don't have a computer), follow the instructions in this section.

You'll need a storage card formatted for the Newton 2.0 operating system.

Before you start using your MessagePad, back up the preinstalled software packages (such as the Newton Tour) on your MessagePad. That way, you'll have a backup of the preinstalled packages that ship with your MessagePad.

- Turn on your MessagePad.
 Follow the setup instructions on the screen.
- 2 Insert a storage card into your MessagePad.
 Make sure you push the card all the way into its slot and lock the locking tab.
- **3** If necessary, format the storage card for use with the Newton 2.0 operating system.

Warning Formatting a storage card erases all information on the card.

When formatting is complete, a card slip appears.

4 Tap Backup.

A slip appears with a list of items to back up.

5 Tap the checkbox next to "Backup all packages."

6 Tap Backup.

Your MessagePad backs up all packages to the storage card.

- **7** When the backup is complete, tap **■** to close the card slip.
- **8** Unlock the card slot and push the release lever to release the storage card.
- **9** Set the storage card aside for safe keeping.
